The following information was extrapolated from Facebook posts in whole or in part.

January 26, 2025: Included these two photos.

Eric Wunz posted "*The new oak windows for Coach* #20 are half done. 28 more to go in Feb. The old ones were 35 years old, stained, and falling apart".

March 14, 2025: Included the next two photos.

Eric Wuntz posted "Had to replace over half of the wood arches above the windows on Coach #20. Old ones were falling apart. Have the new arches and the upper windows in.

The mahogany pieces that hold the lower windows were sun and water damaged and needed to be sanded and revarnished. Took them home to do that and they will be ready on Sunday to install the lower windows".
